Some 1988/1989 GL1500 owners may complain about water leakage into the saddlebags while riding in the rain or washing the motorcycle.


An improved saddlebag body seal is now available. The new seal is preformed and thicker, eliminating the need for the lid seal.

APPLICABLE MOTORCYCLES

All 1988 and 1989 GL1500s

SEAL REPLACEMENT PROCEDURE

 Remove and discard the left and right upper saddlebag body seals. Leave the lower body seals in place (both sides).



2. Remove and discard both lid seals.

NOTE: The lid seal is not required with the new, thicker body seal.

3. Remove any glue residue on the saddlebags or lids.

- Attach the new seals using Hondaline Weatherstrip Cement (H/C: 1724426), 3M Fast-Tack #08031, or equivalent. Follow the manufacturers directions to assure complete drying.
- 5. If necessary, adjust the latches so the lids will open and close easily.

NOTE: If water leakage continues after this repair, contact your Customer Service Representative or call Tech Line (800-421-1900) for assistance.
